Jesus Feeds Five Thousand

Bible Base: Mark 6:34 - 44

Key Christian Belief: Jesus is the Son of God who does miracles.

STRATEGIES USED:

- Simple language
- Makaton signing for key words
- Use of repetition
- Structuring the story – 5 scenes
- Use of “First ...” / “Then ...” and “All done”
- Use of visuals – video story and physical objects (bread and fish)

WAY IN

FIRST we are going to LOOK and LISTEN, THEN we are going to TELL. It's a story from the Bible about something amazing that Jesus did.

FIRST look and listen.

Now that you have LOOKed and LISTENed we are going to TELL the story together. There are 5 scenes. How many scenes? 5 scenes.

STORY-TELLING

SCENE 1

Hundreds and hundreds and hundreds of people had listened all day to Jesus teach about God and his love. Everyone was tired and hungry. Tired and hungry.

SCENE 1 ALL DONE!

SCENE 2

Jesus' 12 disciples asked Jesus to send the crowd away to get food but Jesus said, “You give them food”. “You give them food”.

SCENE 2 ALL DONE!

SCENE 3

The 12 disciples asked hundreds and hundreds of people, “Have you food?” The answer from everyone was NO. NO. NO. NO.

Then a boy gave his lunch of five loaves and two fish.

SCENE 3 ALL DONE!

SCENE 4

ONE lunch – 5 loaves and 2 fish

not enough to feed everyone here,

not enough to feed everyone in the crowd that day

but the boy knew that Jesus could do something amazing.

Jesus lifted up the 5 loaves and 2 fish to God his father, thanked God and asked God to bless.

SCENE 4 ALL DONE!



SCENE 5

Then something amazing happened.

With 1 lunch – five loaves, two fish, 100s + 100s of people, over 5000 people, got food.

And even more amazing - there were not 1, not 2, not 3, not 4, not 5, not 6, not 7, not 8, not 9, not 10, not 11, 12 baskets of left-overs!

That day everyone learned who Jesus is - Jesus is God's son and Jesus is amazing!
